#### ✓ 1. What is Web Hosting?

- Web Hosting is a service that allows your website to be accessible on the internet.
- When you create a website using WordPress, all the images, files, and data need to be stored somewhere. That "somewhere" is a web server, provided by a hosting company.
- Hosting is like renting a space on the internet where your website lives.

Example: Like you need land to build a house, you need hosting to build a website.

#### 2. How Does Hosting Work?

- When someone types your domain name (e.g., <u>www.cybertechcreations.in</u>), it points to your hosting server.
- The server then sends the website data (pages, images, etc.) to the user's browser.

## 3. Difference Between Hosting and Server

Hosting	Server
A service provided by companies	A physical machine/computer
Made for storing website files	Stores data and serves requests
Includes support, security, tools	Can be managed or unmanaged
Shared or dedicated	Can host multiple websites

## 4. Types of Hosting

#### 1. Shared Hosting:

- Multiple websites share one server.
- Low cost, good for beginners.
- o Example: Hostinger, Bluehost basic plan.

#### 2. VPS Hosting (Virtual Private Server):

- Server is divided into virtual parts.
- More control and speed than shared.
- Good for medium websites.

#### 3. Dedicated Hosting:

- o Entire server for one website.
- Very fast but expensive.
- Used by large businesses.

#### 4. Cloud Hosting:

- Multiple servers work together.
- Scalable and reliable.
- Used by growing businesses and ecommerce sites.

#### 5. Managed WordPress Hosting:

- Specially optimized for WordPress.
- Fast, secure, automatic updates.
- o Example: Kinsta, WP Engine.

  - One-click WordPress install
  - 24x7 Customer Support

Purpose	Helps people find your site	Hosts all your website data
Requirement	Must-have for every website	Must-have for website to go online

- Visit a hosting provider's website (e.g., Hostinger.com)
- Choose a plan (usually comes with free domain)
- Complete registration and payment
- You will get login to cPanel or hPanel to manage site

- After buying hosting, use "1-click install" feature to install WordPress.
- You can now start building your website on WordPress.
